ORDER ON APPELLANT’S REQUEST FOR DELAY OF APPEAL HEARING

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT on the 13th day of April, 2016, came before the Civil Service Commission for hearing regarding Appellant’s request for a delay of the appeal hearing until final disposition of the criminal charges against Appellant.

After considering the arguments of counsel and consulting the relevant laws, the Commission voted in public session.

The Commission finds that Firefighter Steven Pogue’s request for a delay of the appeal hearing until a date certain, July 13, 2016 at 1:00 p.m. is granted.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that Appellant, Steven Pogue, must immediately notify the Civil Service Director, Jennifer Otey, and Fire Chief Sam Rohde, of any pleading he enters regarding the pending criminal charge. For the purposes of this Order, “Immediate” is defined as within 24 hours, and the duty to immediately notify Ms. Otey and Chief Rohde includes any “final disposition,” or any of the following: guilty plea, nolo contendere, probation, deferred adjudication, deferred prosecution, pre-trial diversion, or similar deferred disposition, dismissal, or any other disposition the court enters relating to Pogue’s criminal charges, including any plea bargain Pogue enters including the offense of obstruction of roadway or any other plea. The immediate notification must be made by e-mail, to jotey@ci.duncanville.tx.us and srohde@ci.duncanville.tx.us.
