Item #6 – Discuss Email Sent by Chairperson – Policy and Procedures as Commission Members:

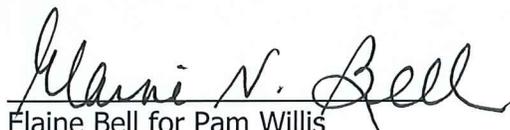

She discussed with the Commission that he made not need to go in front of council because per Bart Stevenson this change would require a large budget. It would be better to postpone the name change and include the request in the budget where several items could be added for the “Rebranding” of the D.L. Hopkins, Jr. Senior Center all at once instead of small pieces at a time. Staff Liaison Madyun is working on the budget for FY 17.
