Discussions were had regarding the presentation put on by Monte Anderson of the Duncanville Design Studio on April 16th, as well as the current condition of Duncanville Neighborhoods.



The Commission received general information from the Secretary regarding the use of Drop Box for agendas and agenda items, their Open Meeting Certifications, and information regarding delinquent property taxes


- The Commission requested the Secretary provide the following items:
