A regular meeting of the Duncanville Virtual Reality Innovation Commission was held on Tuesday, July 14, 2015, at 7:00 p.m. with a quorum present to wit:

The meeting convened in Conference Room B (near Public Works) in City Hall and was called to order at 7:05 P.M.

The Minutes from the June 9th meeting were reviewed and approved at 7:07 P.M. (4 for – 0 against)

Duncanville Economic Development Director, Jessica James, met with the commission and conducted open discussions regarding ideas of how to stimulate the growth of technology and technology related businesses within the city limits.

1. Jessica James suggested that the Commission hold a “focus group” discussion with the current students at EON Reality to determine what sort of resources and infrastructure they would want to see that would entice them to live and work within the city.
2. The commission requested the secretary address Haskell Gray of EON Reality about holding this discussion with the students.

The secretary gave a report about EON’s expectations of the students, upon graduation, and regarding those still employed with Mountain View College.

The secretary gave a report about Six Flag’s VR product.

The secretary gave a report about future plans for pedestrian access across HW67 from the Field House and regarding the grill at the same location, indicated that a yet-to-be-released study on the Field House will be presented to the City Council next Tuesday, which would answer some of the questions about food service at the location.

The secretary gave a report about EON Reality working with the Museum of Cultures regarding a holographic, interactive table as well as math/science products for younger children.

A discussion was held regarding the commission president making a presentation, in the future, to City Council during their work session.

1. Dr. Vergara will begin constructing a PowerPoint Presentation regarding the commission’s actions to date, as well as future recommendations.
