


The meeting convened in the Briefing Room and called to order at 7:08 PM and discussions were held to create a presentation to council, with the following content:

1. Street toppers
 - a. Show a photo of what it might look like
 - b. Allow neighborhoods to choose their own design
 - c. Place at entrances to neighborhoods, not every intersection
 - d. Consider costs of placement, cost and frequency of replacement, and who will manage it (city or neighborhoods)
2. Hollywood Park line of sight issue
 - a. Reinforce that a serious accident will happen
 - b. How will this be resolved
 - c. Discuss options
 - d. Show the single line of sight picture from Ave of the Stars facing south, to northbound Cockrell Hill Road
3. Neighborhood cleanup process
 - a. What can be done to facilitate the process?
 - b. How can the commission start the process?
 - c. Code officer present to give some education to those in attendance
 - d. Neighbors and Neighborhoods together
4. Code enforcement
 - a. Increase code enforcement education process
 - b. Discuss some options to increase public education
5. DIY Garland process
 - a. Present a copy of the DIY Garland "Idea Book" to council for consideration
 - b. Begin discussions about how to start something similar
6. Residential rental property registration
 - a. Discuss the effect of rental property registration in Garland
 - b. Recommend we do something similar
