Charlie Mae suggested wearing the new polo shirts. Next steps include attending the Juneteenth Committee April 3rd meeting.

ITEM 5 Patrick LeBlanc commended Councilmember Cooks on Charlie Mae's recognition during Black History Month as the first African American to serve on a Duncanville Commission. A discussion was held about the City's demographics and the importance of African Americans in this city.
