

Employee Benefits

Vacation

Employees earn 180 hours of vacation per year/15 hours per month

Sick Leave

Employees earn 180 hours of sick leave per year/15 hours per month

Holidays

Employees earn 120 hours of holiday leave per year

Insurance

The City of Duncanville provides medical, vision, dental, and life insurance for city employees

Retirement

The City of Duncanville is a member of the Texas Municipal Retirement System (TMRS). The City matches employee contributions at a rate of 2:1 upon retirement.

Requirements

- Must be 21 years of age but must not have reached your 36th birthday
- Must possess a high school diploma or G.E.D. certificate
- Must be certified as Basic Firefighter Certification with Texas Commission on Fire Protection, and Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) by the Department of State Health Services

OR

- Must be certified as EMT-Paramedic or Licensed Paramedic by Texas Department of State Health Services
- Must possess a valid class C Texas drivers license and have a good driving record
- Must be able to obtain a Class A or B license within one year of hire
- Must be a U.S. citizen
