The meeting convened in the Council Briefing Room and called to order at 7:00 PM

Regarding agenda item 1, a motion and second were made to approve the minutes from the August 31st Regular Meeting, passing 4 in favor

Regarding agenda item 2, the Commission received a report from Commissioner Thompson regarding the Comprehensive Plan community meeting, held on the 19<sup>th</sup>. Much of what was discussed came from the community meeting. Commissioner Thompson states much of the community feedback matches the ideas of the DNV. Other important topics were land/neighborhood development, gateway markers on major thoroughfares to set Duncanville apart from other cities, development around the Fieldhouse, commuter rail development, and a realistic/implementable plan.

Regarding agenda item 3, the Commission received a report from the Assistant City Manager that everything was ready to go for PIP Days and it would be carried out over Friday the 30<sup>th</sup> and Saturday the 1<sup>st</sup>. Sponsors were Republic, Costco, and Chicken Express.

Regarding agenda item 4, while no Commissioners attended any other meetings, President O'Brien stated there was very positive feedback from Hollywood Park regarding the thermoplastic marking and it appeared to be making a difference in people blocking the intersection, even without the cross arm installed.

Regarding agenda item 5, the Commission received a presentation from City Planner, Chasidy Allen regarding the Comprehensive Plan. After which, Chasidy engaged the Commission in feedback by giving them the "My Vision of Duncanville" questionnaire.

Regarding agenda item 6, the Commission states they would like a table, a sign, and candy to give out at National Night Out.

Regarding agenda item 7, there were no public comments made.
