 Firefighter Aaron Martin graduated from UTSW Paramedic School on January 8, 2016, and graduated Valedictorian of his class.






Accomplishments:

- I. Smoke Detector Installation Program:
 - Launched the Smoke Detector Installation Program on March 4, 2016, and to date we have installed smoke detectors in 15 homes.
 - We have partnered with American Red Cross, Home Depot, CERT, Batteries & Bulbs, Southwest Printing, and Centro Familiar Cristiano to assist with neighborhood installations, within each council district, over the next 6 months. The 1st neighborhood installations are scheduled in the Hollywood Park area (District 4) on 04/23/16, from 09:00a 12:00p.


