- On June 27, 2016, City of Duncanville was recognized as a “StormReady” Community by the National Weather Service




Accomplishments Q3:

IV. 2015 Assistants to Firefighters Grant (AFG)

- Awarded 2015 Assistant to Firefighters Grant for Firefighter Wellness & Fitness
- Total Grant Value: \$79,043
City Contribution 10% Match: \$ 7,904

V. Smoke Detector Installation Program:

- Completed Home Depot Grant
 - Installed over 245 smoke alarms
 - Knocked on 281 doors
 - Made contact with 133 residents
 - Checked, replaced batteries and/or installed smoke detectors in 102 homes
- Through the valued partnership with American Red Cross, we will continue the Smoke Alarm Installation Program.
 - Next Neighborhood Installations scheduled for Saturday, July 23, 2016 in District 2



Accomplishments Q4:


VI. Smoke Detector Installation Program:

- Completed Neighborhood Installations in District 2
 - Knocked on 85 doors
 - Made contact with 37 residents
 - Installed a total of 43 detectors
 - Checked, replaced batteries and/or installed smoke detectors in 22 homes, and of the 22 homes, 11 of these homes had no smoke detectors, or no working smoke detectors in their home.

- Next Neighborhood Installations scheduled for Saturday, Nov 19, 2016 in District 1.

VII. New Quint Apparatus Ordered

- New Quint was ordered in September 2016
- Expected Arrival is October 31, 2017




In the News:



