Commission member Smithey made a motion, seconded by Commission member Powers. The vote cast was 4 for, 0 against.

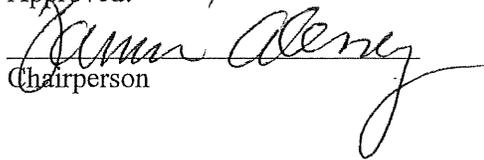
**Item No. 3 STAFF REPORTS: -UPDATE ON DISD MEMORABILIA LOAN PARTHERSHIP**

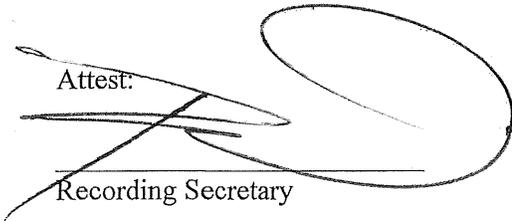
