Gale Sliger made a motion, seconded by Ralo Thompson, to approve the minutes of the March 6, 2017 meeting. The vote was unanimous.

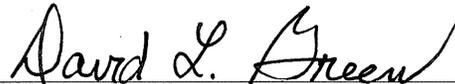
A presentation was made by members of the Freese and Nichols, Inc. team including Shad Comeaux, AICP, Tiffany McLeod, and Jason Claunch with Catalyst Commercial. The presentation included the a recap of the comprehensive planning process, an overview of the progress of the Comprehensive Plan and further discussion on Future Land Use Map, transportation improvements and gateways.

were discussed which included the identification of seven key corridors, that operate well below existing capacity, that complete streets treatments may be applied to improve connectivity and facilitate economic development. Discussion followed and the Steering Committee voiced some concerns with the bike lane treatments. Freese and Nichols explained that the bike lanes were an option that can be utilized and may not ultimately be implemented on every corridor. Discussion ensued with the need for further explanation to be had on this topic.

The presentation concluded with a general consensus of the direction of the Future Land Use Map, transportation improvements and gateways but further discussion is desired to formalize the final recommendations.
