

**RESOLUTION NO. 2017-020**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUNCANVILLE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE FOR AND RECEIPT OF A GRANT FROM THE TEXAS OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, CONTINUING FUNDING FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT CRIME VICTIM ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, FOR FY2018 AND FY2019, WITH A TOTAL GRANT VALUE OF \$117,377.85, OF WHICH THE CITY OF DUNCANVILLE SHALL PROVIDE A TWENTY PERCENT (20%) CASH AND/OR IN-KIND MATCH REQUIREMENT ASSOCIATED WITH THE GRANT AND SHALL COMPLY WITH SAID REQUIREMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$23,475.57; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AS THE AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS IN REGARD TO THE REQUESTED FUNDS, WHICH INCLUDES THE AUTHORIZATION TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, REJECT, ALTER OR TERMINATE THE GRANT.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council for the City of Duncanville finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Duncanville that a Crime Victim Assistance Program be funded for Fiscal Years 2018 and 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council for the City of Duncanville agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council for the City of Duncanville agrees to provide applicable 20% matching funds for the Crime Victim Assistance Program as required by the Criminal Justice Division, Victims of Crime Act grant application; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council for the City of Duncanville wishes to designate the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUNCANVILLE, TEXAS:**

**Section 1.** That the City Council for the City of Duncanville authorizes the City Manager or his designee to submit an application and accept the Grant to the Office of the Governor, Texas Criminal Justice Division (CJD), to maintain funding assistance for the Fiscal Years 2018-2019 Crime Victim Assistance Program in the amount of \$117,377.85.

**Section 2.** That the City Council for the City of Duncanville assures the awarded funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor, Texas Criminal Justice Division (CJD), in full in the event of loss or misuse of the CJD funds from such grant.


**Section 3.** That the City Council for the City of Duncanville acknowledges and approves a twenty percent (20%) cash and/or in-kind services match requirement associated with the grant and shall comply with said requirement in the amount of \$23,475.57.

**Section 4.** That the City Council for the City of Duncanville authorizes the City Manager, as the authorized official, to execute all documents in regard to the request and grant funds, which includes the authorization to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant.

**Section 5.** That the City Council for the City of Duncanville agrees and directs the City of Duncanville will comply with other rules set by the Criminal Justice Division of the office of the Governor of Texas applicable to said grant.


