**Item No. 1 - Approval of Minutes:**

A motion was made by Mayor Green; seconded by Commissioner Harvey to approve the minutes from the July 13<sup>th</sup> Regular Meeting, passing 4-0 in favor.

**Item No. 2 – Discuss planning for trip to Monasterolo in 2018:**

President Sandra Ciarochi has been in communication with Monasterolo di Savigliano, Liberation Day a city festival in Monastrollo di Savigliano will be held on April 25, 2018. Planning a trip around nine to ten days during the week of April 15-25, 2018 would be the ideal time to travel.

Commissioner Harvey agreed stating it seemed to be more of a framework and desire to establish the relationship between both cities.

Discussion between commissioners took place in holding a regular meeting, deciding on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of each month.

**Item No. 5 – Receive Public Comments:**

Linda Greuling spoke in favor of including Dario Crosetto to the Sister City Commission, stating he means well and we should let the past go, with him being a hometown son of Monasterolo di Savigliano he should be included in the program.


