The meeting convened in the Council Briefing Room and was called to order at 7:03 PM by Chair Ciarochi.

Item No. 1 - Approval of Minutes:

A motion was made by Mayor Green; seconded by Commissioner Duhon to approve the minutes from the September 14th Regular Meeting, passing 6-0 in favor.

Item No. 2 – Discuss meeting second Tuesday of month:

Discussion between commissioners took place in holding a regular meeting in the City Hall Briefing Room, the 2nd Tuesday of each month. A motion was approved 6-0.

Item No. 3 – Discuss planning for trip to Monasterolo in 2018:

Discussion on flight options took place. Chair Ciarochi presented information from American Airlines, a group rate for 10-20 passengers averaging \$1,450.00 per person. Departing from DFW International Airport with arrival in Rome via Air Italia. Vice Chair Kamm stated she will provide pricing from Air France. Chair Ciarochi questioned how to promote the trip to other organizations around the City; Duncanville Chamber of Commerce, Duncanville ISD, and Duncanville Rotary Club. Discussion took place to provide a PowerPoint to the Rotary Club, advertising on the City's website, advertising on the LED sign at the Chamber of Commerce, and creating a flyer with information stating the relationship between both cities.


Item No. 4 – Discuss possible recognition ideas for Monasterolo di Savigliano:
