Board Members Present: Lee Burton, Sylvia Clark, Cindy Copeland, Chair Bobby Cutler-Hill, Julie Lee, Barbara McComb, Margaret Shrum, Mary Ann Taylor, and Vice-Chair Joe Veracruz were present for the meeting.

Board Members Absent: Daneshé Bethune, Emily Gwynn, Dotti Pennebaker, Liz Smith, and Dorothy Wolverton

City Staff Present: Timothy Hamilton, Parks Superintendent and KDB Staff Liaison (SL) was city staff in attendance.

Chair Cutler-Hill noted a quorum and called the meeting to order at 8:36a.m.

1. Public Discussion Period:

No one was in attendance for public discussion.

2. Consider approval of minutes of the regular meeting and Annual Retreat held November 10, 2017.

Chair Cutler-Hill asked if everyone had had time to read over the November 10, 2017 minutes. A motion was made by Board member Clark to accept the minutes as written; a second was made by Board member McComb. A vote was taken with a unanimous approval of 9 for and 0 opposed. Board members Bethune, Gwynn, Pennebaker, Smith, and Wolverton were absent from the vote.

3. Discuss the wrap-up of the Toy & Coat Recycling Drives to end December 8, 2017.

SL Hamilton requested that all Toy and Coat Recycling Drive boxes be picked up and returned to the Lions Park storage building on Monday, December 11, 2017, preferably in the AM if possible. A photo op with all toys collected would be at First Christian Church on a date and time TBD.

4. Discuss 2018 KDB Calendar to include future meeting and event dates.

Upon review of the 2018 KDB Calendar, it was recommended to move the Annual Retreat and October's meeting to Friday, October 12, 2018 from October 5, 2018.
