

## **V. Fire Safety Calendar**

- Fire Prevention kicked off their annual Fire Safety Calendar Contest for all 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade students attending Duncanville ISD schools within the City of Duncanville.
- The Fire Prevention Office has partnered with Duncanville Firefighters Association to sell the calendars. All proceeds from calendar will be donated to the Parkland Burn Camp, Camp I-Thonka-Chi.
- The American Legion – Post 81 presented the Fire Department with a sponsorship of \$2,150 which will be used to send (4) children to Parkland Burn Camp, I-Thonka-Chi, and the remaining donation will be used to offset cost of printing the Fire Safety Calendars.




## **VII. Emergency Operations Center**
