

# City of Duncanville Trash & Recycle 2018 Holiday Schedule



## Upcoming Holidays

There will be **no trash or recycling services** on the following holidays. There are **NO MAKE UP DAYS** for these services. Trash Service will resume on your next scheduled trash day and your Recycling Service will

### Fourth of July

Wednesday, July 4th

### Labor Day

Monday, September 3rd

### Thanksgiving Day

Thursday, November 22nd

### Christmas Day

Tuesday, December 25th

### New Year's Day

Tuesday, January 1st 2019



## Trash Services

- All garbage, recycling, and small piles of brush (4' or less) should be in your designated pick up location **NO LATER THAN 7 a.m.** on scheduled collection days.
- Garbage should be placed **SECURELY** in plastic **GARBAGE** bags (2 mil rating), no greater than 30 gallons in capacity, and cannot weigh more than 50 pounds per bag. Trash bags are considered secure when they are tied tight, have no holes or tears. Any loose trash will not be picked up by the garbage crews.

## Recycling Services

Recycling bins should only contain acceptable recyclable items. You can find a list of these items on the city website at [www.duncanville.com](http://www.duncanville.com)

Do not place your recyclables in plastic bags and do not place trash bags in your recycling bins. The bins will not be serviced.

## Bulky Item Information

- Old furniture, toilets, televisions, appliances (freon free) and other items that are too large for trash bags should be placed out with regular trash. There is no scheduled day for bulky pick up. The second trash day of the week is best since there is more room in the trash trucks.
- Construction material, dirt, rocks, appliances containing freon, **WILL NOT** be picked up by the city's contracted garbage crews.
- Grass clippings are only picked up if you purchase a grass sticker for \$2.75 per bag from Republic Services.

## Brush Pick Up Services

- Small piles of brush must be cut in 4' lengths or less, stacked neatly and bundled with rope or twine weighing less than 50 pounds per bundle. Place small bundles with your trash and recycling.
- Large piles of brush **must be placed out front for pick up**, no exceptions. Brush over 4' in length will **NOT** be serviced in the alleys. **BRUSH PILES MUST BE CLEAN AND FREE FROM ALL OTHER MATERIALS.** Place large piles near the curb. Large piles cannot be more than 3' in height. Obstructions such as vehicles, mail boxes, utility lines, poles, and other trees, etc. will prevent the brush piles from being serviced until the obstruction has been cleared. Under normal weather conditions large brush piles will be serviced within 1-14 days.
