On Saturday, May 4th, Duncanville registered voters will head to the polls to elect a Council Member At Large, as well as Council Members in District 1, 3 and 5 (elected by voters who live in the respective district).

Applications are available at the City Secretary's Office, located in City Hall at 203 E. Wheatland Road. The first official day to file for a place on the ballot is Wednesday, January 16 and the deadline to file is Friday, February 15 at 5:00 pm.
