Item No. 2 Discussion on Planning for 2019 Monasterolo delegation visit to Duncanville:

The Sister City Commission discussed tour locations for the Monasterolo di Savigliano delegation. The General Motors plant will not be available as there are no tours scheduled for Thursday, October 24th. The Commission also discussed possible events to attend on Friday, October 18th due to there being no Duncanville High School home football game. In its place, Commissioner Balagna suggested a restaurant that played Mariachi music. Chair Ciarochi stated that Veracruz Restaurant in Cedar Hill is willing to cater a dinner.
