

The City of Duncanville contracts with Republic Services for solid waste management, which includes trash and recycling collection, as well as brush and debris removal.

## Brush & Bulk Collection

Brush and bulk debris are collected together once per month in your regular trash collection location.

Combined, the brush and bulk debris **should not exceed four cubic yards.**

Commercial and construction brush and bulk waste will not be accepted.

## Brush

Small piles of brush, limbs, and tree trimmings

- + Branches and long brush must be cut in four foot lengths
- + Brush, trunks, and limbs cannot exceed six inches in diameter
- + Secure brush in bundles weighing less than 50 pounds with twine or string
- + If a third party tree trimmer or landscaper is used, make sure they remove brush debris from property
- + Yard waste less than two inches in diameter should be placed in a bag or box and the weight cannot exceed 50 pounds



## Bulk

Bulk items are considered household items such as furniture, mattresses, tables and appliances

### Acceptable Items

- + Stoves
- + Dishwashers
- + Water Tanks
- + Fencing materials
- + Household debris
- + Refrigerators and window units (freon must be removed and tagged by certified technician)



### Unacceptable Items

- + Tires
- + Carpet
- + Flammables & hazardous waste

Residents who have brush and bulk in excess of four cubic yards can contract pick up service with Republic Services for a fee (approximately \$100 per hour) or contract with a third party to haul away additional brush and bulk debris.

# Trash

Trash collection is provided twice per week

Trash is collected in plastic garbage bags left at the curb or alley

- + Loose trash will not be picked up
- + Leaves placed in bags is acceptable
- + Trash bags must be 30 gallon capacity or less, and/or bags cannot weigh more than 35 pounds each
- + Secure bag (knot/twisty tie) and make sure bag has no holes or tears
- + Place trash out neatly and separate from other items like recycling and brush/bulk debris
- + Wrap broken glass and mirrors in newspaper to ensure you, and the collection crew, are safe from potential cuts and injuries



# Recycling



Glass is no longer a recyclable item and the recycling market is changing. For almost three decades American recyclables were shipped to China to be sold and recycled. Due to various economic factors, China no longer accepts the world's recycling waste and the market has subsequently suffered. Google 'Operation National Sword' for more information regarding recycling.

Recycling collection is provided once per week

Recycling bins are owned and provided by Republic Services, and should be left at the home when moving. Replacement recycle bins are available by calling Republic Services at 972-225-4207

Residents can rent a 96-gallon rolling cart from Republic Services for an additional monthly fee by calling 972-225-4207

All recyclables must be clean, empty and dry

### Acceptable Items

- + Paper
- + Aluminum containers and tin cans
- + Plastic containers marked #1, #2 and #5
- + Boxes with no wax coating or food residue
- + Magazines, junk mail and soft cover books

### Unacceptable Items

- + Glass
- + Styrofoam
- + Plastic bags
- + Medical waste
- + Diapers/clothing/textiles
- + Anything with food/liquid residue
- + Carton-style containers with gable top
- + Household hazardous waste and/or containers
- + Plastic containers marked #3, #4, #6 or #7 (or no number at all)

- + Thursday Zone 1C Residents
- + Friday Zone 2D Residents


Place trash and recycling at the curb/alley no earlier than the morning of, and no later than 7:00 am, on scheduled collection days.

No Construction Materials will be picked up. These items will need to be disposed of by the contractor doing the work or taken to Skyline Landfill for a \$35 fee.

## Household Hazardous Waste

The City of Duncanville holds a Household Hazardous Waste collection event each spring. Residents can also dispose of waste at the Dallas County collection center year-round and free of charge with proof of residency.

## Tips

- + To keep animals away from trash bags, spray bags with a household ammonia and water solution.
- + Do not leave children's toys and bicycles near the trash collection area.
- + Old motor oil and car batteries can be recycled at most auto parts stores.
- + Place a dryer sheet in the trash can to keep your trash can smelling fresh.
- + Plastic bottles are generally recyclable, but the lids are not; please remove the lids and throw in trash prior to recycling bottles.
