The City of Duncanville started its full-scale recycling program in January 1996. In 1999, the one-sort recycling system was implemented. The one-sort system allows all items accepted in the recycling program to be placed together inside the green and blue recycling bins.



Items Accepted for Recycling:

- Aluminum Cans
- Tin or Steel Food and Beverage Cans
- Plastics #1 thru #7 (Containers, Bottles, Jugs and some Plastic Bags)
- Always look for the Recycle Symbol and Number on the bottom of these items.)
- Glass Jars and Bottles (**any color**)
- Paper Products
 - Newspaper, Magazines, Catalogs, Computer Paper, Cereal Boxes, Flattened Cardboard Boxes, Office Paper, Envelopes, Junk Mail, Paper Back Books, Brochures, Pamphlets, and Brown Paper Grocery Sacks

Recycling is picked up once a week. Recycle bins should be placed at your pick up location by 7:00am on the day of pick up.

Items Not Accepted for Recycling:

- Styrofoam
- Pizza Boxes
- Plastic Bags without the Recycling Symbol and Number
- Plastics that contained Household Hazardous Waste (oil, anti-freeze, etc.)
- Aerosol Spray Cans
- Wax Coated Containers
