SUBJECT: Collection of Racial Profiling Data	Directive: 2015-1

I. PURPOSE

In an effort to accurately collect the data required by Duncanville Police Department Regulation 5.41, Section VI, members of the Duncanville Police Department will collect the data in the following manner. **Senate Bill 1849 Racial Profiling Reporting requires a Department collect racial profiling data any time an Officer conducts a motor vehicle stop.**

II. DIRECTIVE

**All Officers** will input the necessary Tier 1 Racial Profiling data into the electronic ticket writer when taking enforcement action. **A peace officer who makes a motor vehicle stop must report to the Police Department the following information:**

- Gender
- Race/Ethnicity
- Initial reason for the stop
- Location of the stop
- Whether a citation or written warning was given as a result of the stop
- Whether an arrest was made and the basis for the said arrest
- Whether physical force was used which resulted in bodily injury
- Whether a search was conducted and if so was the search consensual

**Warnings may be substituted for citations or arrests when circumstances warrant this course. This is especially true in the case of inadvertent and/or non-hazardous violations. In the event a warning is issued, it must be a written warning. Verbal warnings are NOT permissible.**
