I. PURPOSE

It is the intent of the Department that each member be adequately attired so as to present a proper, neutral, and professional image of the Department.

II. DIRECTIVE

~~A. — Effective on the date of this directive, no future uniform items may be personally purchased and worn, unless included in the Department uniform contract. Any previously approved, personally purchased items, or previously approved uniform items, may continue to be worn until no longer serviceable. Example: pullover, polo style uniform shirts, fleece shells, alternate winter jackets, etc.~~

B. Replacement will be issued on an even exchange basis, with the turn-in being made at the time the replacement is issued.

C. Each officer will be authorized the following:

1. One “Class A” dress uniform, as needed. This will be poly/ wool, long sleeve shirt (not Super Shirt) and poly/wool four pocket pants (not six pocket pants). Uniform tie will be worn with the “Class A” uniform.
2. Three “Class B” daily wear uniforms, four OR six pocket pants, and Super Shirt, long or short sleeve.

D. Optional “Class B” daily wear will be Armor Skin Base Shirt, long and short sleeve, AND the Armor Skin outer vest carrier. IF this option is chosen, the Armor Skin outer vest carrier MUST be worn over the Armor Skin Base layer shirt, ONLY. Armor Skin shirts cannot be worn OVER concealable body armor, and the Armor Skin vest carrier cannot be worn over super shirt or “Class A” uniform shirt.

- E. No name tape, embroidery or other marking are approved. All shirts will have ONLY two department shoulder patches sewn on, unless the officer is currently assigned to the Tactical team, in which case One TACTICAL rocker is allowed above the left shoulder patch.
