I. OBJECTIVES

To assure efficient and appropriate attention to duties and responsibilities by delineating activities which are destructive to effective performance by personnel.

II. RULES

A. Except as noted, employees shall not engage in the following activities during duty hours:

1. Sleeping (unless authorized), loafing, idling and/or loitering at garages, service stations, or facilities of other governmental services such as fire stations, city hall and courts.
2. Recreational reading or viewing of television, except at meals and in such a manner so as not to bring discredit to the professional image.
3. Private business or personal transactions.

B. Except upon assignment of a supervisor or in the line of duty, employees shall not enter drive-in-movies, places of amusement or recreational events, or park in the vicinity of such for the purpose of viewing activities for amusement or entertainment.
