I. OBJECTIVES

To assure accident reduction through effective law enforcement aimed at accident causing violations, which have been shown to be significantly involved in collisions and officer presence at the time and places of high accident experience.

II. RULES

A. Except when other duties prevent it, officers shall patrol and take enforcement actions in accordance with the tenants of selective enforcement aimed at accident reduction by:

1. Reading departmental publications and studying maps, which indicate the times, locations, and violations significantly, involved in this city traffic accident experience.
2. Taking vigorous enforcement action when any violation shown to be significantly involved in causing accidents is observed.
3. Patrolling high accident locations during times when the accident experience has been shown to be significant.

B. Officers in doubt as to the nature of details of information provided by the department to promote selective enforcement for traffic accident reduction should seek clarification from supervisors utilizing the chain of command.
