I. OBJECTIVES

To assure professional law enforcement efforts by employees of this department and cooperation efforts between this department and the community.

II. RULES

A. Conduct unbecoming is any conduct which adversely affects the morale, operations, or efficiency of the department or any conduct which has a tendency to adversely affect, lower, or destroy public respect and confidence in the department, or any officer or employee. Conduct unbecoming also includes any conduct which brings the department or any officer or employee into disrepute or brings discredit upon the department, or any officer or employee. Officers and employees shall conduct themselves at all times, both on and off duty, in such a manner so as to reflect most favorably upon the department.

B. Employees shall maintain a level of moral conduct in their personal and business affairs, which is in keeping with the highest standards of the law enforcement profession. Employees shall not participate in any incident involving moral turpitude, which impairs their ability to perform as police employees or cause the department to be brought into disrepute.
