The regular meeting via videoconference was called to order at 7:01 PM by Chairperson Taylor.

Item No. 1 – Receive public comments, limit 2-minutes per individual speaker:

Item No. 3 – Discuss the Martin Luther King Jr. Day of Service opportunity:

She mentioned service opportunities that can be done virtually from home such as transcribing. She requested if the board would be interested in doing a proclamation for Martin Luther King Jr. Day of Service.

SL Hamilton advised Chair Taylor that the City will most likely be doing a proclamation for Martin Luther King Jr. Day but he would contact the appropriate City staff to confirm.

Item No. 4 – Discuss the KDB Annual Garden Workshop to be held March 6, 2021:

SL Hamilton shared that the KDB Annual Garden Workshop event is currently scheduled to be held on Saturday, March 6, 2021. After short deliberation, the board unanimously made the decision to postpone and move the event to Fall 2021. The date being considered is Saturday, September 25, 2021. Chair Taylor and board member Arnold volunteered to help with the planning for the event.


Item No. 5 – Receive staff report/updates
