



Business Beautification Award Guidelines

Up to one non-residential building in Duncanville is recognized each quarter for significant improvements to the exterior portion of a building, landscape improvements, and/or long-term maintenance of the non-residential property that exemplifies high quality standards. Award recipients receive recognition at a regular City Council meeting, an article in the City newsletter, and a sign to display at their place of business during the quarter they are selected.

The Keep Duncanville Beautiful (KDB) Board nominates the Business Beautification Award. The property must be in good standing with the City's Code Enforcement and Building Inspections Departments. The KDB Board reserves the right to select properties as warranted and is not bound to select a property every quarter.

The KDB Board follows the criteria identified below:

- Property must be retail/professional office/commercial/industrial or other business use.
 - Property must be located within the city limits of Duncanville, Texas.
 - Significant exterior improvements and/or superior maintenance of the property must be made to the property, or the property is new construction.
 - Improvements can include new landscaping, repainting a building, paving a parking lot, adding awnings, new signage, etc.
 - Property must not have received a Business Beautification award within the last two years
